

National Chengchi University Directives Governing the Implementation of Academic Research Ethics Education Course

Amendments approved on March 21, 2016, by the 1st Academic Affairs Meeting, spring semester, Academic Year 2015-16.

Article 1 National Chengchi University formulates the NCCU *Directives Governing the Implementation of Academic Research Ethics Education Course* (hereinafter referred to as "Courses") to enhance the research ethics literacy of master's and doctoral students, and to have the correct ethical cognition and attitude required for academic research.

Article 2 Students enrolled in master's programs, in-service master's and doctoral programs from the Academic Year 2015 onwards (including students apply to register one semester in advance) shall complete Courses before the end of the academic year of admission in principle.

Article 3 The implementation of Courses is as follows:

1. Students must read the courses on website of the Center for Taiwan Academic Research Ethics Education and pass the final exam to obtain a course completion certificate.
2. Students whose departments offer academic ethics courses as compulsory courses may be exempt from taking Courses.
3. Students who have already completed the relevant courses of "Academic Ethics Education" should apply for exemption by submitting a certificate in the academic year of admission. Upon approval, they will be exempt from taking Courses.

Students must pass the final exam or obtain an exemption approval before they can apply for their degree examination.

Article 4 Courses shall be implemented with approval from an Academic Affairs Meeting. The same procedures shall apply to any subsequent amendments.
